**THANK YOU** for volunteering to help with the Tampa Bay Blues Festival 2018 on April 6, 7, & 8. We hope you enjoy the event and have lots of fun! Please remember to wear your volunteer wristband which designates you as a volunteer. You may pick up the wristband at the **volunteer tent behind the stage directly to the south of North Shore Pool**.

**Charity:** Our festival has benefitted PARC ([www.parc-fl.org/](http://www.parc-fl.org/)) since 1995! Please visit their website and the booth at the festival.

**Location:** The Festival is at Vinoy Park, south of North Shore Pool and the softball field. It is directly on the water (7th Avenue and Bayshore Drive NE, St. Petersburg). Please be prompt, as gates cannot open until all volunteers are in place. Gates will open approximately 45 minutes before the music begins each day.

**Where to Go Upon Your Arrival:** The check in booth is located just north of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE and Bay Shore Drive. Please check-in at the volunteer tent. If you don't check in, we won't know you are there and you will be excluded from next year's festival. Please arrive at your designated time, as the volunteer tent is not staffed outside of check-in hours.

**What to Wear:** Please dress comfortably and bring sunscreen. Generally, all of our volunteer positions require standing for your shift. If you serve beer, your shoes will get messy!

**Alcohol!** Volunteers may be asked to serve beer & wine. Please be aware that rules regarding serving beer & wine will be posted at the beer trucks & wine tent. Each volunteer must sign a statement that they have read the City of St. Petersburg's rules regarding this type of vending. **No alcohol can be consumed by volunteers while they are working at the event.** You must show proof of being 21 in order to serve beer & wine. Beer Taps will be shut down at 9:30 p.m.

**Sales.** You may be asked to serve beer, wine, soda, or sell festival merchandise. All sales will be overseen by a festival manager and security personnel. If you are selling drink tickets, please know that **tickets are good for day of sale only! If guests purchase tickets late in the day, please make sure to point this out to them.**

**Parking:** Due to the limited reserved parking area, all volunteers are directed to park wherever they can find a spot. We will attempt to furnish you with a parking pass for parking at the softball field by North Shore Pool and the Tennis Court parking lots; however, space/passes are limited and we cannot guarantee a spot. You can always park in the South Core or Sundial parking lots and take the free shuttle to the event. The shuttle pick up spots will be First Avenue South/First Street – in front of Al Lang Field and a stop in front of the Sundial parking garage on First Street.

If you have any questions, please direct them to the volunteer coordinator at the back of the venue (behind the stage area).
